
Table Status - Table Register

The **Table Status** column in the PNG Table Register describes the current operational status for tables in the RAMM system. The diagram below visualises the different status options. It shows how a table can progress through these options depending on the current operational state of the table.



Each table status option can be described as follows;

Table Status	Status Description
Proposed	The table is in a work-in-progress state, either in the design/development stage for a
	new table(s) or an existing RAMM table being considered for active use.
Maintained	The table is in active use.
System Managed	The table is in active use and is primarily maintained by the RAMM system.
Automated	The table is in active use and is primarily maintained by an automated process.
Archived	The table was previously in use but is now no longer actively maintained.
Not Used	The table hasn't been used before, and there is no current intention for it to be used.
	There may be no information in the table, or it could be storing historical information
	migrated from other systems.
Not Used (AMDS)	A subvariant of the Not Used status. This option is used for Asset Management Data
	Standard (AMDS) tables that are not in use, and which have been set to Private in
	RAMM. The generic <i>pngsys</i> account has been given access permissions to these tables.
